THE ROUTES

With three distances on offer there is a route option to suit all abilities. All routes start and finish at the Curry's Post Primary School.



Route Description: 85km

The 85km comprises two different loops to create a figure eight effect. The first 43km loop comprises the 'western front' and takes riders on a testing route with over one thousand meters of ascent over district, forestry and farm roads before returning to the Curry's Post School. There will be one refreshment table at around the 20km point and a second one back at the school. The second loop, namely the 'eastern front' incorporates more of the Karkloof valley side and doubles as the 45km race.

Route Profile: 85km

Route Description: 45km

The 45km route (and second half of the 85km race) heads out from the Curry's Post School over a gentle incline, followed by a long descent and some lovely rolling terrain on forestry roads before facing a gradual ascent back to the finish. The total climbing is about 850m and there will be one water table at approximately 20km (or 60km for the 85km).

The 45km event is the official E-bike race, with prizes for the top three men and women kindly sponsored by Hattons Cycles.



The 28km route is a shortened version of the 'eastern loop' and follows a rolling descent for the first 12km before climbing out the valley all the way back to the finish.
